It is appropriate that we're doing this now, because this Sunday is also Safeguarding Sunday. This week has seen some horrific news from the church in France, and we've obviously had our own challenges and news in this country in recent years.

I recently attended safeguarding training, and the first question we were asked was: 'What do you think when you hear Safeguarding?'

It is all too easy for the flippant answer to be 'Oh no not again' but what we realised as we talked that this is not about unnecessary or onerous demands upon us, but the challenge to realise that as the People of God we all have a responsibility to act and behave well towards one another and to do all we can to keep each other safe, physically, mentally and spiritually. We also have a responsibility to look out for and look after those who for one reason or another are more vulnerable and who need particular care.

So this weekend please do come to share in worship and to hear about ways that we can be involved in helping to look out for some vulnerable families and individuals in our area.

We're in Kingweston Church and there is news in this bulletin and elsewhere of the concert in Kingweston on 29 October. It will be a music, both instrumental and sung with an interval. We're asking all who come to wear masks and we don't intend for the concert to be very long. Please come to enjoy some public music, being in the company of others and the excellent lighting.
